- Allowances for people who originate from Oceania (Australia, New Zealand, New Hebrides, Indonesia), allowances for other nations may vary.
- Each person over 21 years.
- Each person over 20 years.
- Each person over 17 years.
- Tobacco quantities stated must be of equal proportions between Japanese brands and other brands.
- All tobacco products in the traveller's possession must be declared, duty and GST will be charged.
- Whilst every effort is made to ensure that the above information is correct, Customs regulations can change without any notice.
- Please check with our staff or with the local Customs Authority.
- Passengers should ensure that prior to travelling they are aware of the Customs allowances for countries they intend to visit.
